Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are excited to announce that it is Dollywood time! We will be going on May 13 with the DMS chorus. We will be leaving the school at 7:50 and will be staying until the park closes at 7:00 p.m. The cost of the trip will be \$60 per person (Money is non-refundable). Parents are invited (and needed) to attend as well as any additional family members. Dade County Schools have enacted a new bus policy that does not allow anyone but school employees and students to ride the buses. If you or your family are planning to attend, you will need to provide personal transportation. If you have season passes, you do not have to purchase tickets to go, but we do need to know how many band/chorus students are going for seating on the bus. This is a PBIS reward trip for students who are actively participating positively in rehearsals, being respectful, and conducting themselves as leaders in Dade County Bands and Dade Middle School. Students will not be allowed to attend this reward trip if they repeatedly disregard the expectations set forth in the Band Handbook and the Dade Middle Student Handbook and/or are assigned ISS during the 4th nine weeks. The \$60 cost will cover the following items:

- 1. Bus ride to and from the park (school bus).
- 2. Admission to the park.
- 3. 1 meal ticket

A deposit of \$30 will be due by Tuesday, March 22. Final payment will be due by Monday, April 4. If you wish to attend, we need all money turned into us by Monday, April 4. This date guarantees that we have all money to Dollywood on time to receive the appropriate ticket price. No late payments will be able to be accepted.
