

Student and Chaperone Trip Expectations and Guidelines

A. Chaperone Rules and Responsibilities

1. **NO alcoholic drinks** are to be consumed while on this trip. (In front of students or privately in your room.) We must set a great example for the students!
2. Keep students with you at all times while on the trip. Students may change groups while on the trip ONLY if both sets of chaperones agree to let students change and the teacher is notified.
3. At curfew each night, help make sure students are not only in their rooms at the designated time, but that the rooms are also in an orderly manner. (This will save us time at check-out.)
4. Keep all female students out of male student's rooms and vice versa.
5. Chaperones are expected to follow all itinerary items and rules.

B. Student Rules and Responsibilities

1. All school rules will be enforced while on this trip. (This includes dress code, conduct, smoking, consumption of alcoholic drinks, etc.) You are on a school trip and can be punished accordingly if necessary. Please don't make it necessary!
2. Students will not be allowed to use the pool at the hotel during this trip.
3. Keep your rooms clean and keep the noise to a minimum.
4. Female students are NOT allowed in male student's rooms and vice versa.
5. **Curfew will be set each night and will be strictly enforced.**
6. All students will be assigned to small groups. While on the trip, students must stay with their chaperone at all times. You will not be allowed to just roam around by yourself.
7. If you even remotely think that anything you plan on doing needs to have permission first, then DON'T DO IT.
